- To build environmental & watershed awareness/canoeing skills through experiential adventures
- ॐ Spaces are limited to 12 participants entering grades 5-8 or ages 10-13, unless otherwise noted.
- Applications will be accepted through May 1, 2020 at the latest. First come-first served. Selected participants will be notified by email regarding enrollment status and further.
- All materials will be provided including canoes, paddles, life jackets. You must bring lunch/snacks.
- No skills required; canoe skills will be taught; life jackets will be worn on the water at all times.
- Drop off/pick up at Northbrook Canoe Company each day, 1810 Beagle Road, West Chester, PA (for directions, visit <a href="https://www.northbrookcanoe.com">www.northbrookcanoe.com</a>)
- Agenda (tentative and flexible, depending on weather and number of camp days); in case of severe weather conditions that are not canoeing-friendly, we will do alternative activities on land.
